Spring Medal 2011

The date for the Spring Medal is **Tuesday 26th April**.

Attached is a list of those who indicated on their returns they would like to play. If you cannot now do so or will not be at the dinner in the evening, please let me know no later than **Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> April**. If you are playing and attending the dinner, there is no need for you to reply, as I will assume that you will be doing both if I do not hear from you.

Anyone not on the list who would like to play or attend the dinner, should let me know, also by Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> April.

The draw will be emailed and posted on the website over the Easter weekend, no later than Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> April. Those not on email may contact me by phone for tee-off times.

We will be at Strathmore. The 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> tees have been booked from 1.07 pm. Play from the yellow tees. Please be ready in good time before your tee-off.

The green fee this year is £20.00. Please pay this direct to the office before play, along with the £5.00 sweep.

Full handicaps will be allowed up to the maximum of 28. Anyone without a handicap, speak to me. Reductions of 2 for winners last year of any of the Spring, Summer and Autumn Medals, the Captain's Salver and Tullibardine Cup.

Score cards, completed, checked and signed in the usual way, must be handed in to me, or my nominee, before you leave Strathmore. No late card will be accepted – see Rule 6.6.b.

The Windsors compete for the Society's Gold Medal and Pitfour Silver Medal, and the Middletons for the St Martin's Cross. This is the first opportunity for the well seasoned players to open their challenge for the Captain's Salver, and this too is the first leg of the Tullibardine Cup. Crested tankards (paid for from sweep monies) will be presented to the winners and runners-up as usual.
